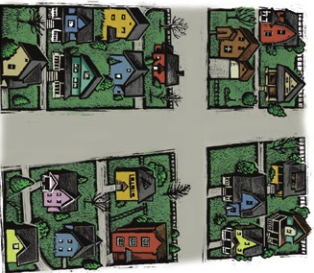

OUR WORK

Inner City Christian Federation exists to provide housing opportunities and services that encourage family responsibility and independence, while building healthy, vibrant communities. Our work is shaped by the belief that all people deserve safe, clean, and affordable housing. It is marked by justice and mercy and the desire to see Christ's love in action.

OUR IMPACT

Emergency Housing - Family Haven is a five-unit emergency shelter for homeless families in the Grand Rapids area. Guests work closely with ICCF staff to overcome issues related to homelessness and to locate affordable housing.

Affordable Rentals - ICCF manages and owns over 160 affordable rental units including several scattered site duplexes, multi-unit apartments, and innovative, mixed-use housing opportunities.

Home Ownership - ICCF constructs between 10-12 single-family homes each year for low to moderate income families. Each home is designed to blend into the local area to help preserve neighborhood character and to serve as an inspiration to other homeowners.

Financial Empowerment Initiatives - ICCF's educational programs equip families to more successfully address financial challenges and build assets. Initiatives include home ownership and financial management classes, individual development accounts, pre-purchase counseling, and more.

OUR VALUES
